

IHS Alumni Association Minutes Monday June 8, 2015



**Meeting Called to Order**: The business meeting was called to order at 7:03 pm by Dale Veverka (70). There were 26 members and several guests in attendance.

Pledge of Allegiance: Dale Veverka. After the pledge, the board members introduced themselves.

**Treasurer's Report:** Treasurer Bob Wagner (66) distributed copies of his report of June 7, 2015 to members. We have a balance of \$7,629.63 in the checking account. Membership income for this period totaled \$720.00. Donations for the same period totaled \$815.00. Expenses for Educator of Excellence Award totaled \$183.31, Year Book ad \$250.00, Home Day tickets \$50.00 and Graduating Senior Awards \$750.00. The Treasurer's Report was accepted as written.
